Course content:

The course is arranged into seven modules:

1. Introducing Managing Safely

5. Controlling risks
6. Investigating accidents and incidents
7. Measuring performance.

Assessments

Classroom students take an end-of-course assessment with 30 multi-format questions, then a work-based risk assessment task within two weeks of the course.

Online students must complete the course, assessment and risk assessment task within five months of registration.
